Enrollment Agreement

So that each parent and student understands school policies, we ask that you read the following information and initial next to each statement and sign this form indicating your agreement and understanding of the policies set forth. 1. Students are to show respect in relation to the faculty and in speaking to faculty members. The first rule of conduct should be to show consideration of others at all times. 2. The use of profanity, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, illegal or unauthorized drugs on campus or off campus at any time, are serious violations of the standards of Carolina Christian Academy and will lead to expulsion. Students are not allowed to leave the school grounds during school hours without permission from proper school authorities. The school is not responsible for the loss of personal property, whether it occurs by theft, fire, or any other cause. Carolina Christian Academy reserves the right of dismissal of any student who persistently and willfully neglects his academic work, exercises poor citizenship, reflects adversely on the Christian principles of the school or generally fails to cooperate with instructors or administration. He or she may be expelled indefinitely. Attire and appearance appropriate to the occasion is expected of all students at all times, and students are expected to adhere to dress code guidelines as described in the student handbook. Students should consider it a privilege to attend Carolina Christian Academy, and therefore, do all in their power to keep the building attractive. Any student known to deface or destroy school property will be assessed the full cost of repairs and be subject to possible disciplinary action, including dismissal. All students enrolled at Carolina Christian Academy must have in their school file a birth certificate, social security number, school physical, valid immunization records, and current custody papers if applicable. It is the sole responsibility of the parent to provide the school with any changes or updated legal documents. ___Carolina Christian Academy admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate in the administration of its educational policies, admission policies, scholarships, athletic and other school administrative programs. 10. _____ A student handbook will be furnished to each student. As parents, and students, we agree to read and adhere to the policies and guidelines set forth in the student handbook. 11. _____Any form of homosexuality, lesbianism, bisexuality, fornication, or pornography is a violation of the standards of Carolina Christian Academy and will lead to expulsion. 12. As parents, we agree that Carolina Christian Academy may use my child's picture in its promotional and periodical literature for school use. 13. _____I agree to the financial policies of Carolina Christian Academy and I understand that payments for tuition and fees will be made by the first of each month and if late, my account will be billed a late charge of \$25. If my payment is past due for more than thirty calendar days my child may be withdrawn from school until my account is made current. My child is permitted to take part in all school activities, including but not limited to, sports and school sponsored field trips, and absolve the school and church from any liability to me or my child in case of accident or injury to my child while on campus or during any school sponsored outing. As parents, we sincerely pledge our loyalty to the aims and ideals of the school. As parents, we hereby invest the authority in the faculty and administration concerning the discipline of our child as necessary. We further agree that we will support the faculty and administration at home as needed. As parents, we agree, in accordance with the principle of KJV Matthew 18:15-17, to bring any and all questions and criticisms to the person most directly involved. If we have a question about a specific classroom action or procedure, we will contact the appropriate teacher. If a satisfactory conclusion is not reached, we will then contact the principal. It is understood that all students are accepted on a trial basis for the first grading period (30 days) before grade placement or enrollment becomes final. Carolina Christian Academy is not equipped to handle E.H., S.L.D., A.D.D., or A.D.H.D. children. 20. _____I agree to comply with and support the spiritual, moral dress and disciplinary standards and policies of the school and further agree that the school has full discretion in the discipline of my child while under school supervision. Carolina Christian Academy uses a filtered internet system. As parents, it is our responsibility to notify Carolina Christian Academy in writing if we do not want our child to have internet access at the school. 22. I understand that if I or any agent acting in my behalf or on the behalf of my child, brings any illegal action against the school or its agents and such legal action is found in favor of the school or its agents, I will be responsible to pay all legal fees and other expenses related to such action. All disputes shall be settled in binding arbitration. I understand that in signing the Enrollment Agreement, I am agreeing to accept and abide by the rules and philosophy of Carolina Christian Academy.
